RE: Access Key & River Safety

Dear Acadian,

There are 2 control gates located at the end of Riverlook Lane. These control gates give you access to canoe/kayak portages into the Saluda River: (1) Hunter's Creek Landing at the PaddleHouse, and (2) Scott's Landing at the end of Cassie's Run foot trail. Please help keep the gates locked except when you are using the trails for access. This will help reduce curious visitor traffic on our pedestrian trails.

The gate key is located in a combo box on side of the PaddleHouse gate. The code is **2008**. The silver key unlocks the gate. The black key unlocks the developer's kayaks, which you may use by request to Caleb Freeman at 864.304.1111. Be sure to lock and replace keys in this combo box for the next Acadian visit.

A copy of this gate key will be available also at the Acadia Sales Centre during office hours.

PLEASE USE SAFETY VESTS, AND DO NOT PADDLE ALONE. HAVE FUN, BUT PLEASE BE CAREFUL. AND REMEMBER, DO NOT DISCARD ANY TRASH. HELP KEEP OUR SALUDA RIVER CLEAN. THANK YOU.
